Admission Procedure

Admission will be given according to the policy devised by the Government. Admission in Intermediate and Bachelors program will be given in accordance with the policy announced by the Board and University of the Punjab. The students who passed annual exam in 2021 will be given priority. Those students who passed exam in supplementary will be eligible for admission only against vacant seats. The students who have passed Matriculation and Intermediate will be given admission in first year and third year respectively. The merit list of qualifying students will be pasted on the Notice Board. The Admission Committee can debar the admission of any student in case he is found to be involved in unethical and illegal activities. In case a student does not pay fee within due date, his name will be removed from the list and his place will be awarded to next waiting candidate.

Only those students who pass Matriculation and Intermediate will be given admission in first year and third year respectively.

A student fail in a subject but having pass result card will not be eligible to take admission in that particular subject in which he has failed.

Age Limit for Admission

As per letter by the Govt. of the Punjab vid.50(coll)7-5/84 dated 13.03.1989 the age limit is as under:

Inter: (18 Years)
BA /BSc (22 Years)
M.A: (26 Years)

The deserving students will be given concession in college fee as rules. For disabled students, there is no age restriction.

Method to Submit Admission Form

Prospectus can be obtained from the college office. The duly filled admission forms must be submitted in the admission office according to the given time table. The students will mention their name and father's name according to matriculation certificate.

Attach the following documents with admission form:

- 1. Two attested copies of Matric /Inter result card / certificate
- 2. Good Conduct Certificate from the last attended institution. In case of private students, a character attestation certificate verified by a grade 16 or above class officer.
- 3. For 1st Year: 06 pictures in size (2``×2½) in white background

- 4. For 3rd Year: 06 pictures in size (2``×2 ½) in blue background
- 5. If the student has passed matriculation from some other board, then Original Board Migration Certificate (NOC) and its one attested copy.

Note: Without this admission form will not be received.

- 6. Attested copy of Father / Guardian CNIC
- 7. Student's B-form is necessary. Note: Admission form will not be received without it.
- 8. At the time of admission, student must give relevant affirmation (that is given at the back of admission form) that if he misbehaves or disrespects, the principal may expel him from the college.
- 9. Disability certificate (the disability certificate established by MS of Govt. Hospital for getting admission on particular seat will be accepted)
- 10. For soldier quota, application must be given by Army GHQ and list provided by GMQ will be final consideration.
- 11. Attach the required admission form with all documents in file cover and submit in the office. Admission form will not be received without file cover and after deadline.

Fee and Fine Payment

Fee and Fine payment will be done on specific dates as specified by the college.

Struck off after Admission

If a student remains absent for 10 days in any subject or all subjects, his name will be struck off. He will have to apply for re-admission in accordance with struck off notification. Besides, for re-admission, he will have to pay special fine and admission fee.

Note:

- i. Both theory and practical attendance will be counted for science students.
- ii. If a student's name is struck off twice, he will lose the right of re-admission.
- iii. If a student is found in indiscipline, misbehavior or malpractice, the college administration reserves the right to take proper disciplinary action against him.

Migration

A candidate shall be eligible for migration as board / university rules provided.

- a. He falls within the college merit
- b. A seat lies vacant in the college
- c. Documentary evidence of change of address

However, the final decision lies with the Principal.

Class Attendance

Only those students will be eligible to appear in board / university exam who follow the following criteria of class attendance along with other conditions:

- a. 75% attendance in each subject
- b. In subjects which include practicals, 75% attendance in the specific period (practical) provided practical periods are not below 40.
- c. 72 hours manual work in academic terms before exam.
- d. No relaxation / relief will be provided in the lecture count in case of leave, illness or any other reason.
- e. 90% attendance in mandatory for BS students

Absence Fine & Special Fine

In case of violation of college rules, special fine may be charged which is not remissible.

- 02 rupees will be charged for absence in each lecture.
- In case of absence from college exam / UMC, 200 rupees will be charged.
- Liberal use of Mobile Phone will result in 1000 rupees fine.
- Smoking / misbehaving with college officials / workers.
- 150 rupees will be fined to students without uniform.
- If students are found quarreling among themselves, they will be fined.
- Facilitating activities of foreign organizations.
- Damaging college property.
- Remaining absent from classes continuously.

Leave Rules

- a. Students of F.A / F.Sc should get two-day leave approved by their English department.
- b. Leave for three or more days should be got approved by the concerned senior teacher / Dean of Arts / Dean of Science / Dean of Commerce or the vice Principal.
- c. Medical Leave for more than four days will be granted on the basis of Medical Certificate issued by the medical Officer or MS of the Government Hospital.
- d. The leave application should have the father's signature, student's name, Roll Number, Class, Year, section and Date clearly mentioned.
- e. BS students should submit their application in Room No. 125 after getting it approved by the Head of Department / Dean of Science / Dean of Arts or the Vice Principal.
- f. Intermediate students should submit their application in Room No. 23.

Fee Concession

- a. Fee concession applications must be submitted on the specific form immediately after admission in the college. All such applications must bear father's / guardian's signature.
- b. Concession will be granted on the basis of discipline, regular attendance and satisfactory performance in studies.
- c. Granted fee concession can be refuted to such students who are either unable to perform satisfactorily in the college exam or violate college rules.

Scholarships

Scholarships special offered by the Government, University, Board and local bodies can be granted in the college. However, poor performance may lead to refusal of the scholarship.

ID Card

Newly admitted students must collect their college ID card from the Physics Lab within 15 days of the admission. In this connection, 04 Passport size Pictures of the student in white background bearing student's name, Roll Number and father's name at the back must be submitted in the college office during admission. 50 rupees will be charged for the ID card. In case ID card is lost, the student will have to pay 100 rupees as fine for the new card. However, the card will not be issued the third time. Each student is required to display college card during college hours or else disciplinary action will be taken against him.

College Uniform

As per the Government guidelines, college and school students are required to wear the same uniform at an institution. It is aimed at identifying students easily and encouraging them to avoid wearing expensive dresses. Following are the uniforms for students of the college.

Note:

Neck Tie is part of the uniform but if a student opts for it, it should not be any color other than Maroon.

Complaints / Suggestion Box

A Box outside the college has been placed for the students to register their complaints or suggestions. Such applications should contain name and Roll Number of the student who writes a complaint or suggestion. The Principal will take appropriate action upon these applications.

> Notice Boards

All the announcements from college are posted on the Notice Board. All the students are advised to check the Notice Board regularly. The students are considered informed once the announcement has been posted on the Notice Board. Any claim of misinformation shall not be entertained.

Discipline / Code of Conduct

The purpose of college education is not only curricular studies but also character building through discipline. The students are required to follow the code of conduct. The students are advised not to be part of any immoral, indecent and submissive activities and law and order of the college. The students should respect the teachers. They should act gently with their fellow students and sort out their mutual issues amicably.

> Discipline Committee / Proctorial Board

To ensure discipline of the students, a Proctorial Board that comprises of a few teachers exists in the college. It assists the students in resolving their problems.

> College Library

College Library contains books related to every subject. There are about thirty thousand books and every section has been added with mare books to facilitate the students and teachers. A student can get one book issued against his / name for a duration of 14 days. If a book is not returned within due date, a fine of Rs. 5/- per day is charged from the student. The reference books can only be studied in the library premises. Within one year of final exams, the security fees must be refunded if the student applies.

College Exams

Mid-Term exams are held in mid December whereas, Pre-Board exams are held in first week of the March. Students must participate in these because based on these exams result, registration to the Board or University is confirmed. Registration is withheld in case of poor academic performance. Absence in exams results in fine of Rs. 200/- per exam.

> Rechecking

If a student wishes to get his paper rechecked, he can get it done by paying one hundred repees per subject.

Book Bank

In addition to college library, a book bank has also been set up. College students, teachers and other citizens donate their books to book bank. The curricular books are available at the book bank and these are issued to deserving students for the period of two years so that they can benefit from it.

Educational events at College

In addition to the Debating Society, Majlis-e-Iqbal, the Islamic Society, Bazm-e-Shirani, Pakistan Ideology Society, Scientific Society and the Commerce Society have been set up. These ensure healthy cultural and educational activities and improve the literary writing and speaking skills of the students. Prominent students and speakers are given special prizes.

> Pakistan Ideology Trust Society

Under this society Pakistan Ideology, Pakistan Movement and several personalities related to it are the topic for different competitions and exhibitions.

➤ The Red Crescent Society

The deserving students are provided books and college uniform by this organization.

➤ Medical Aid

In order to provide a first aid to the students there is a dispensary in the college where a part time doctor and a trained dispenser work.

> The Environment and Scouting Society

Environment and Scouting society is also one of the other several societies in the college.

> Publications

Magazine: The college students have their own literary and educational publication named "Marghzar". It includes the writings by teachers and students. Special marks for this are also issued at important events.

Information: This is a concise information booklet of the college that publishes once in every three months. It mentions all the happenings in the college. Different societies report their college activities in this publication.

➤ College Council

All the important matters and issues are addressed by the college council which is headed by the college Principal. This council presents its recommendations regarding discipline, college dues, education and code of conduct to the Principal. These are acted upon after approval. The students who are involved in any immoral or indecent activity are punished by the college council. The punishment may include fine and even expulsion. College council is also authorized to punish any student found guilty of using illegal means to pass exam.

> Rules and Regulations for Admission to Hostel

- 1. The application form for hostel admission is available at college office. Application form has to be submitted immediately after the admission.
- 2. Hostel administration allots rooms according to rules and regulations.
- 3. The residing students will be responsible for the safety of everything in their rooms.
- 4. The hostel will be evacuated during vacation.
- 5. Attendance for all the residing students is taken at 07:00 am. and 09:00 pm. daily. Every absence will be fined Rs. 10/-. Any student that remains missing for seven days from the hostel will be terminated from the hostel list.

> Prohibitions

The following actions are prohibited:

- 1. Damaging the hostel property.
- 2. Keeping a pet or a big cash amount.
- 3. Playing cards, radio or using heater.
- 4. Keeping fire, arms or knives.
- 5. Keeping guest without permission.

Note:

If any action is not included in the above list, it can later be included upon college council's permission.
